## REMOTE HANDSET CODING INSTRUCTIONS ATA: EAT - MANUAL RELEASE CORD BUTTON

## TO CODE YOUR NEW EAT BUTTON USING THE MOTOR PANEL

If you have access to the motor operating your door/gate, you can use these instructions. However, if the door/gate motor is shared with other tenants at a residential/commercial complex, **do not** use these instructions.



- 1. Ensure your new battery is installed correctly in the new EAT
- 2. Remove the Plastic shield (IF one is in place) covering your motor panel button
- 3. Press and hold down the DOOR CODE button on the motor panel (keep it held down) whilst you:
- 4. Press the EAT button for TWO SECONDS, release for TWO SECONDS, then press it again for TWO SECONDS (see Figure 1)
- 5. Release the DOOR CODE button on the motor panel
- 6. Press the EAT button to test operation of the door

## TO REPLACE THE BATTERY IN YOUR EAT:

- 1. Rotate the cover Clockwise to OPEN the bottom of the EAT (see Figure 2)
- 2. Use a non metallic object (such as a pen) to flick the button shaped battery out of the circuit board (see Figure 3)
- 3. Place the new battery into the battery holder, then firmly press down until it is fully positioned (see Figure 4)
- 4. Sit circuit board into bottom of the EAT case (it should sit into the grooved section)
- 5. Rotate the cover Anti-clockwise to CLOSE the bottom of the EAT






